- Travel West on Occidental Rd to the light at Hwy 116.
 (4.5 miles) Most cell phones will not work past this point
- From the light at Hwy 116 continue straight west on Occidental Rd to the stop sign in the town of Occidental (14.1 miles)
- Very slight right onto Hill St. (144 ft). Turn right on Bohemian Hwy
- Drive north on Bohemian Hwy until you see a large sign saying "Sonoma Canopy Tours" and "Alliance Redwoods" on the left (2.2 miles) Turn into the driveway.
 Park and proceed to the Sonoma Canopy Tour tent and check in with our parking lot greeter/driver.




